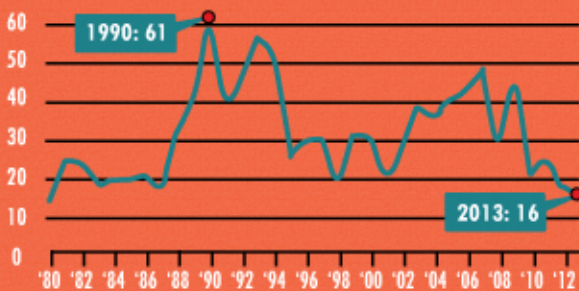

Richmond's anti-crime efforts pay off

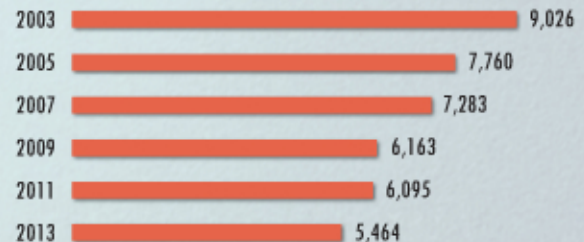
Lowest homicide rate in 33 years

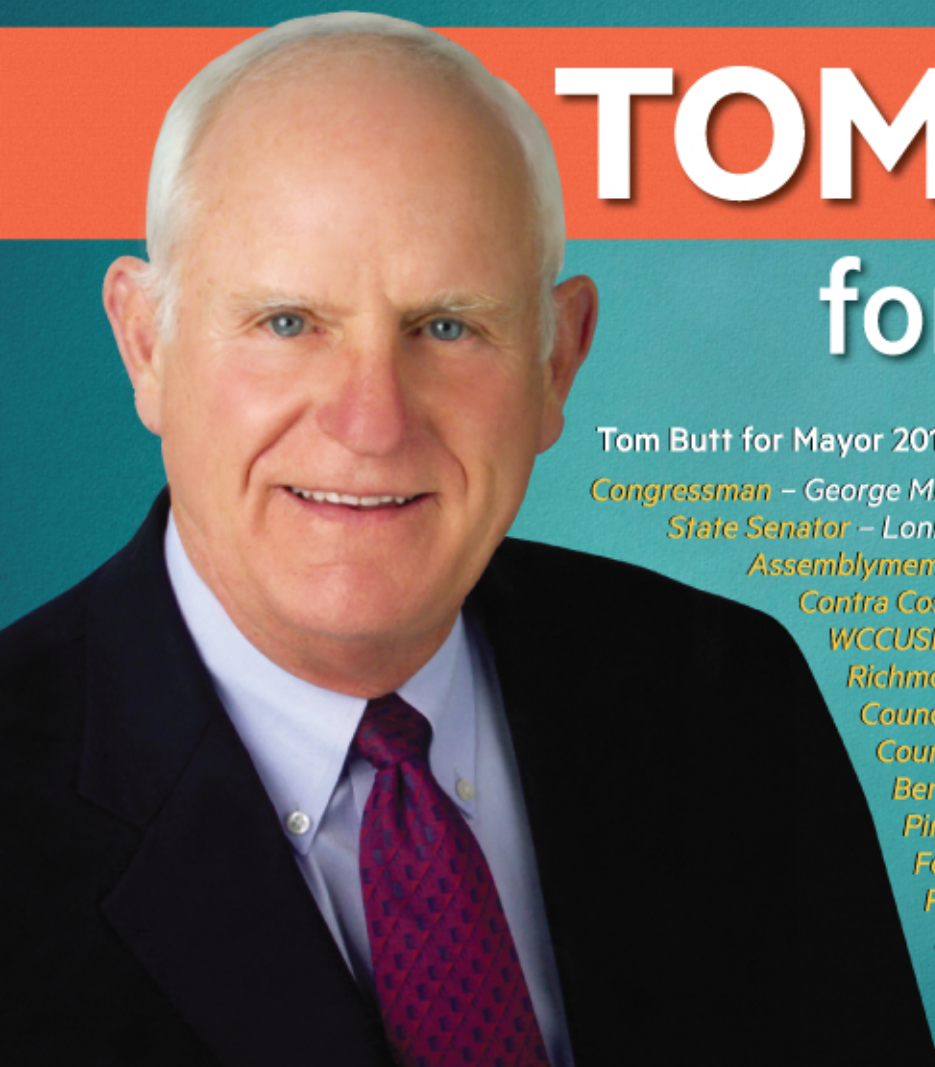
