A FENCE PERMIT IS REQUIRED TO CONSTRUCT A RESIDENTIAL FENCE OF ANY HEIGHT
The City of Richmond has amended the Fence Ordinance regulating the construction of fences on private property

CONFORMING FENCES



If your fence was built without a permit, you must obtain a fence permit OR register with the amnesty program to avoid receiving a citation and/or fine.

For details on obtaining a fence permit, Contact the City of Richmond Planning Department at (510) 620-6706.

The following types of fences are NOT eligible for amnesty and **must be modified or removed immediately:**



- Front yard fences over 6 feet in height
- Solid (more than 50% opaque) front yard fences over 4 feet in height
- Fences within 25 feet of a corner that are over 3' 6" high and more than 20% opaque
- Dilapidated fencing
